

1. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The first Day of the event kicked off with an opening plenary with an address by the host Commissioner for Transportation Dr. Frederic Oladeinde welcoming the participants...

1.1. Opening Plenary

The event kicked off with a plenary session. The host state gave a welcome address delivered by the Honorable Commissioner for Transportation Dr. Frederic Oladeinde welcoming the participants. This was followed by the a special remarks by the outgoing Chairperson of the Nigeria Transportation Commissioners' Forum Hon. Ramatu Mohammed. Goodwill messages were also delivered by stakeholders in the transportation industry preeminent among them was the Corp Marshal, Federal Road Safety Commission, Dr. Boboye Oyeyemi.

1.2. Keynote Address and official declaration of the Event Open

The opening plenary also featured a keynote speaking session by Prof Iyiola Oni, Professor of Transportation Planning and Management before an Executive Plenary Session was convened to dissect the theme of the Event. The high point of the opening plenary was as an address by the Governor of Lagos State, ably represented by the Secretary to the State Government Mrs Folashade Jaji before preceding to declare open, the Transport Technology Exhibition. This was followed by a booth -by -booth tour of the Exhibition Hall before the commencement of other plenary sessions of the day.

Some of the highlights from this year's conference included:

- a. Greater call to integrate Roads, Rail, Air and Water Transportation modes of Transportation to make movement of people, goods efficient and effective.
- b. Deployment of Intelligent Transport Systems (ITS) to improve safety on our Roads, Rail, Waterways and air mode of transportation.
- c. Opportunities for States, who may wish to establish cargo Airport t discuss with relevant authorities in the aviation industry
- d. Call for more funding for the Transportation sector by creating special funding model where private sector will contribute a certain percentage of the profit to the fund.
- e. Call for a harmonious working relationship between the Federal Government and interested State Governments who may want to establish Light Rail Mass Transit Schemes.
- f. The call for the use of Autogas Scheme piloted by the Nigerian Gas Expansion Program NGEP, as an alternative fuel for automobiles and other prime movers in Nigeria
- g. The call for the need for all tiers of government to understand, internalize and operationalize, to effectively drive the administration, management and operations of some aspects of the transportation industry.
- h. The need for quick passage of the National Transportation Policy that will a sustainable affordable, accessible Transportation system in Nigeria was also highlighted respectively.
- i. The call for the continuous collection, collation and regular updating of data as the bedrock for the deployment of intelligent transportation Systems and policy formulation.
- j. The need to embrace automation of processes as way of leveraging on technology to overcome the Transport and logistics challenges in Nigeria.
